



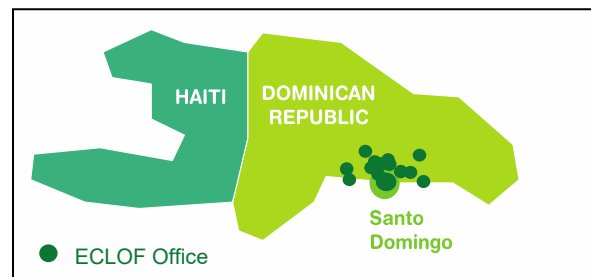
ECLOF DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

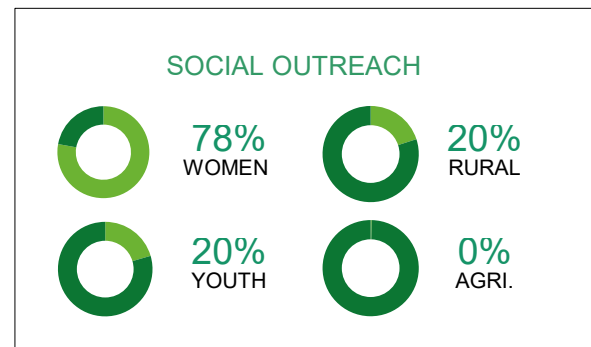

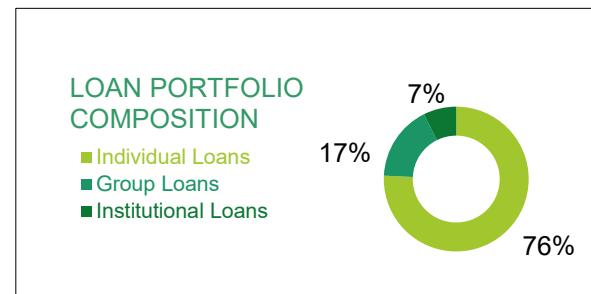
